Christian Education Team meets to consider direction for All Saints Future

The Christian Education Team met on Thursday, May 27 and decided to re-evaluate our Christian Education for the children of All Saints. The decision was made to take the next six weeks to study and creatively come up with a new format that will better meet the needs of our younger children and their parents.

The month of June and at least the first half of July will be used to develop this vital ministry. For the next six weeks the Christian Education program for school age children will be on summer recess. On Sunday June 27 we are asking ALL parents of school age children to meet following church to consider and talk about a new format for our children's spiritual growth. PLEASE mark your calendar now and make every effort to attend this meeting - it is vital to the health of your children's souls.

Due to time constraints, the Christian Education Team was not able to discuss All Saints Adult Christian Education program, however they will be looking at where we are and if we need to change or modify the adult program beginning next September. Dr. Bush's class will make a decision about taking a summer break or continuing throughout the summer when they meet on June 13.

- Fr. Baldwin will be out of town May 19 - 27 to attend the funeral of his grandmother
- Fr. Chuck will be out of town June 3 - 11
- Sara Beth Hansen will be using the church to present a flute recital June 4 and 5

Rector's Warden-Finance - Warmbrod

- 2010 budget is attached to minutes
- Difficulties still remain with installation of financial tracking software; Jim and Fr. Chuck are working to resolve these issues and to move ahead with the new software
- Resolution allowing All Saints to acquire credit card from Regions Bank was proposed, discussed; motion by Shelby, second by Boggs, and passed by acclamation, no opposition; only Fr. Chuck will be authorized to use the card at this time
- Proposal from Alexander, Thompson, and Arnold for church audit is attached. Proposal was discussed; motion by Caylor and second by Shelby to accept proposal, and to proceed with the audit. Motion passed unanimously
- ServePro has been paid for repairs. Negotiations continue with insurance company
- Architect will continue with planning for expansion of church building
- Honduras mission was discussed, prayers were requested
